The applicant must be a resident of Clinton County for a period of nine(9) months and must have been accepted to an accredited two or four-year college or university to be considered for a scholarship. The committee shall consider the following criteria: scholarship, citizenship, personality, leadership, perseverance, resourcefulness, patriotism, general worthiness, financial need, extracurricular activities and awards and all other relevant information.

Scholarship I

The goal of this scholarship is to assist a student in good academic standing that has a financial need in order to pursue a path in a post-secondary school or college. The applicant must complete an essay that would explain this need for financial assistance and should include a list of accomplishments and planned field of study.

Scholarship II

The goal of this scholarship is to give a student who is in good academic standing and interested in a career in business, health or education an opportunity to pursue these paths in college. The applicant is required to complete an essay that should include a list of accomplishments and reason for pursuing a career in the chosen field.

These scholarships, one in the amount of \$3000 and one in the amount of \$2000 will be awarded to a student who has excelled in design in his or her high school career. The applicant must complete an application and essay about an initiated creative design to be considered.

Foundation of the CVPH Medical Center Auxiliary High School Healthcare Scholarship

A total of nine \$1,000 scholarships (one per area school district) are available to 2011 graduating seniors entering a healthcare field such as nursing, physical therapy, occupational therapy, etc.

ARC Foundation of Clinton County Scholarship

Clinton County American Legion "76" Scholarship

This \$200 award is available to the child or grandchild of a member of the American Legion, Sons of the American Legion, or Ladies Auxiliary. The applicant must be attending a two or four-year college (the student can be full or part time).

Clinton County Fire Police Association Scholarship

A \$200 scholarship is available each year to a qualified student attending a certified institution of higher learning. Eligible students shall come from the following groups:

1. Son/Daughter or Grandson/Granddaughter of a fire police person whose department is a member of the CCFPA.
 2. Son/Daughter or Grandson/Granddaughter of a Clinton County Firefighter.
 3. The applicant must be a resident of Clinton County.

School Nurse/School Nurse Teacher Association

A \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a student planning to enter the Nursing Program of an accredited college. The student must fill out the application and write a brief essay about her/himself. Two references and an official transcript are also required.

Dr. Karl R. and Ruth Kramer Northeastern Zone New York State Retired Teachers Association Education Scholarship

The New York State Retired Teachers Association/Northeastern Zone will award two (2) second semester scholarships for \$500.00. One student in Clinton County and one student in Essex County will receive a scholarship. To be eligible, the student must be a high senior accepted at a post secondary institution and pursuing a career in the education field.

Adirondack Regional Federal Credit Union Donald DeVirgeles Memorial Scholarship

To be considered for these awards (one \$750, three \$250, two \$150) students need to write a short essay about why he or she is financially deserving of a scholarship. Applicants do NOT have to be a credit union member to be eligible.

General Harry E. Knight Scholarship

This scholarship is for needy and deserving young men and women who are graduates from Clinton County High Schools and will attend Cornell University.

Sarah S. Vert Scholarship

The scholarship was established to help worthy but needy students of Clinton County to a college education. Worth and need alone are the determining factors in granting aid from this fund.

Champlain Valley Council of Retired Teachers**Jane Boswell Memorial Scholarship**

The group will award scholarships to two seniors attending public high schools in Clinton County, Essex County, or Saranac Lake who plan to go into the teaching profession. An essay (150-250 words) is required that explains why the student wants to teach or what motivated him/her to become a teacher; an explanation for the need for this scholarship; and why the student chose the college that he/she would like to attend.

Clinton County Farm Bureau Scholarship

This \$400 scholarship is intended for a senior interested in pursuing a career in agriculture or agribusiness and who demonstrates academic strength. Selection will be based on academic performance, scholarship application, and letters of recommendation.

Carrols LLC Community Scholarship Fund

Multiple scholarships will be awarded (amount undetermined). Application requirements include student activities, employment history, & community service/involvement.
